Immigrant population

Immigrants make up an important part of local communities in Alexandria and Virginia. Nonetheless, no noncitizen is exempt from the risk of deportation, which threatens the stability and family unity of immigrants and U.S.-born people alike.

Alexandria



38,600 immigrants reside in **Alexandria**, or **25 percent** of Alexandria's population.

Virginia



1.2 million immigrants reside in **Virginia**, or **13 percent** of the total population.

At least **4,800** homes in Alexandria are **owned by immigrants**.




5,600 immigrants in Alexandria are **students** enrolled in pre-K through college or graduate school.


Immigrants in the economy
