

Immigrant population

Immigrants make up an important part of local communities in Wyoming and the United States. Nonetheless, no noncitizen is exempt from the risk of deportation, which threatens the stability and family unity of immigrants and U.S.-born people alike.

Wyoming



21,600 immigrants reside in **Wyoming**, or **4 percent** of Wyoming's population.

United States



47.8 million immigrants reside in **United States**, or **14 percent** of the total population.



The vast majority of children in Wyoming with at least one immigrant parent (95 percent) were born in the United States.


United States

Local community ties



13,100 immigrants residing in Wyoming have lived in the United States **since 2009** or earlier.



1,900 immigrants in Wyoming are **entrepreneurs**.



At least **5,300** homes in Wyoming are **owned by immigrants**.



5,300 immigrants in Wyoming are **students** enrolled in pre-K through college or graduate school.

Immigrants in the economy

Immigrants in Wyoming and the United States are indispensable members of the workforce and contribute to the economy by paying federal, state, and local taxes.

Tax contributions*

Wyoming

Immigrant-led households earned \$941.9 \$941.9M million.

\$60.2M Immigrants contributed \$60.2 million in combined state and local taxes.

\$172.8M Immigrants contributed \$172.8 million in federal taxes.

This means immigrant-led households \$709M have an estimated \$709 million in spending power.

United States

Immigrant-led households earned \$2.4

\$232.1B Immigrants contributed \$232.1 billion in combined state and local taxes.

Immigrants contributed \$419.8 billion in \$419.8B federal taxes.


This means immigrant-led households have an estimated \$1.7 trillion in spending power.

Employment and labor force participation

Wyoming **United States**



14,500 immigrant workers make up 5 percent of the state's labor force.



30.7 million immigrant workers make up 18 percent of the country's labor force.



72 percent of the state's immigrants participate in the labor force, greater than the share among the state's U.S.born population (63 percent).



68 percent of immigrants participate in the country's labor force, greater than the share among the U.S.-born population (63 percent).
