Immigration Court Objection Cheat Sheet

Most common objections for ICE cross

- o **Relevance** (Push back; everything is not relevant!)
- Compound question (2+ questions in one)
- o **Ambiguous/vague question:** (Will create confusion)
- Argumentative; badgering the witness
- Asked and answered
- o Calls for speculation/legal conclusion
- Lacks a question
- Misquoting the witness, misrepresenting the record, improper characterization
- O No foundation/Assumes a fact not in evidence

Objections for ICE evidence

- Untimely; did not comply with filing deadline, no good cause for lateness;
 prejudices respondent
- Lack of authentication; not an original; no chain of custody
- Unreliable; contains hearsay/multiple levels of hearsay; no opportunity to cross; no corroboration or foundation
- More prejudicial than probative
- o Relevance

Other objections

- Leading (ICE may object to you during direct rephrase)
- o Calls for hearsay (Admissible in imm court but may still choose to point ou
- "Your honor I have to note for the record" The non-objection objection where you must note what is happening for the audio record and cannot wait interpreter is sleeping; client is crying; client is pointing to his head; ICE is banging on the table/rolling eyes/shaking head; an uninvited person has come into the room; guards are doing something distracting/disruptive
